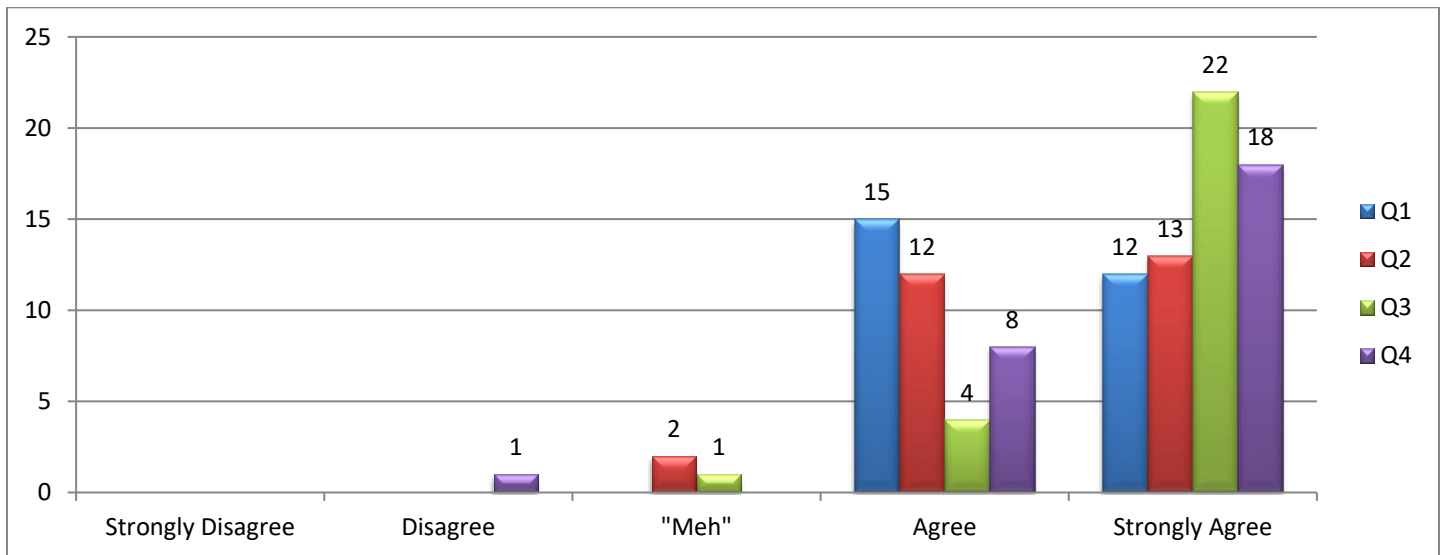


Participant Rating Results
