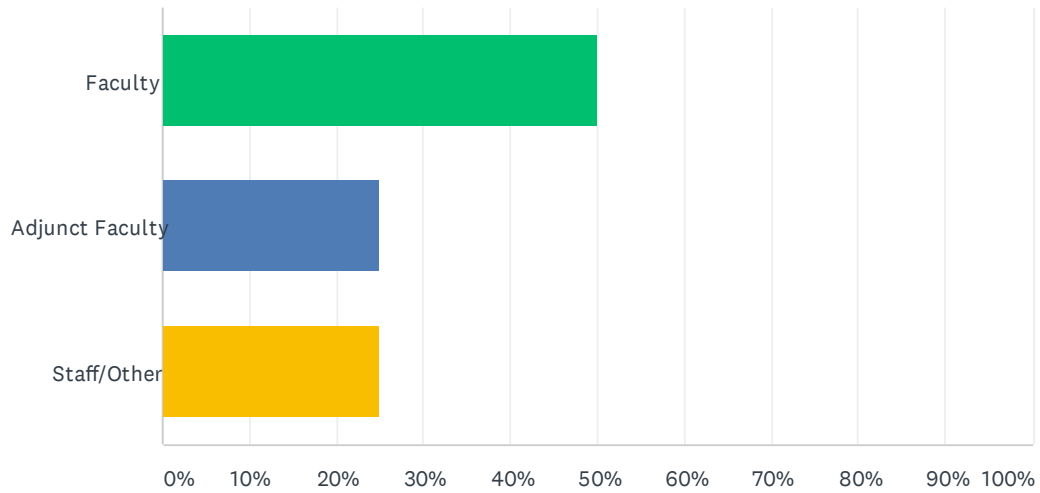


## Q1 What is your primary role at FPU?

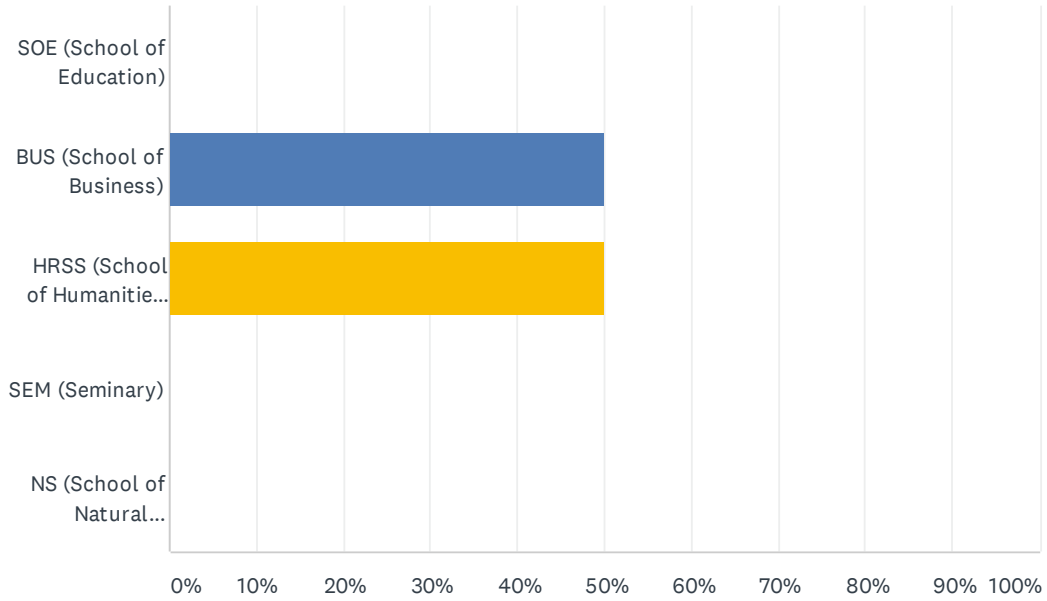

## Q2 What is your primary school affiliation?

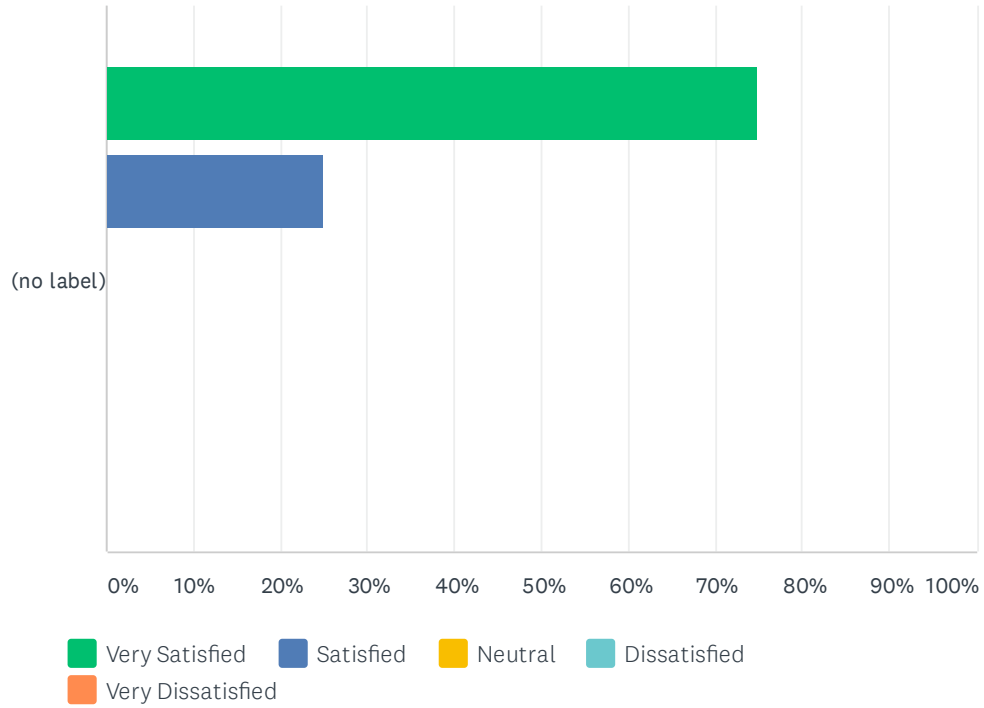

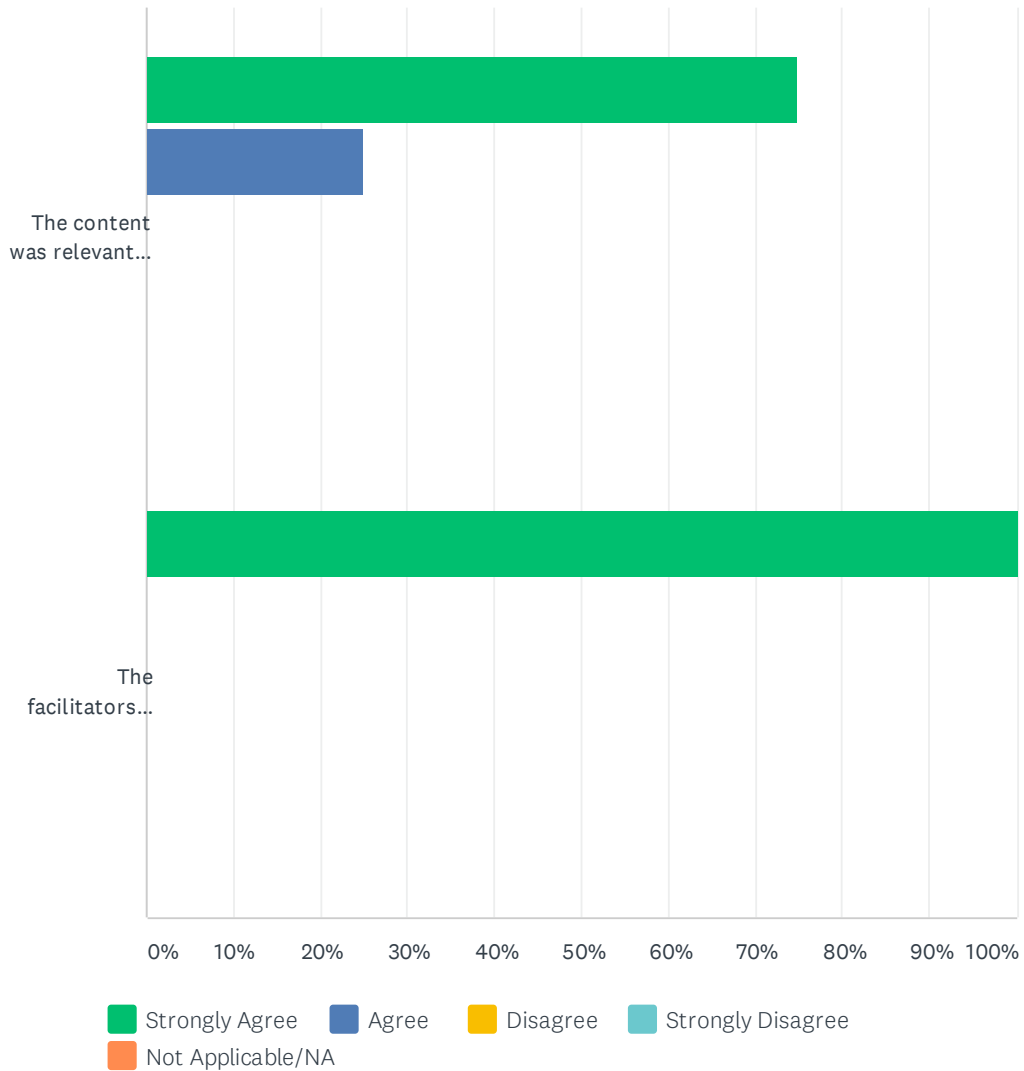
